We appreciate KTA's generous gift of \$3,065.20 from your recent event as a tribute to Daniel Thien.

Every year the Ronald McDonald House of Indiana provides lodging services to over 1,500 families and day-respite services to over 4,000 families; families like Hunter's.

Three-year-old Hunter, from Jonesboro, AR, was born with Hirschsprung's disease, a condition in which intestinal nerve cells fail to form properly during fetal development. The condition causes malnutrition and bowel obstruction as a result of the missing nerve cells. The only viable treatment for Hunter was a small bowel transplant.

Hunter's parents quit their jobs, sold virtually everything they owned and moved 450 miles away from their family and friends so that they could be close to Hunter's doctors at Riley Hospital for Children at IU Health. The search was on for a warm roof over their heads, a place they could call home while they waited for news of a transplant.



The House saved us, Bobby said. We spent every dime we had on hotels, amounting to \$200 a week. We only had \$800. When we needed help the most, the Ronald McDonald House took us in.

After years of struggling, Hunter is now healthier than ever thanks to his transplant.
